BEWARE OF TURNING GOOD THINGS INTO ULTIMATE THINGS

"You shall have no other gods before me. You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below." (Exodus 20:3-4)

Have you ever wondered what an idol is? Tim Keller defines idols as, 'good things that we take and turn into ultimate things that are more important than God.' I like this definition because it reminds us that an idol can be anything or anyone that is more important to us than God. In the first two commandments God makes it very clear that He does not want us worshipping anything instead of him. But how do we know if we have any other gods and idols in our life? This is challenging because sometimes they creep up on us and, if it is a good thing, it can be hard to see when it becomes your new false god. Maybe your desire for approval stops you from sharing your faith with others. Or maybe your passion for sport consumes all your time. Or maybe your level of contentment is totally dependent on your bank balance. If you are wondering what you idolise, then it might help to ask yourself these questions. What disappoints you most about your life? What do you complain about the most? Where and why do you make financial sacrifices (where is your treasure)? What worries you? Where do you seek comfort when you are hurting? Where do you invest the biggest portion of your thoughts, time and energy? What takes you away from serving God and loving others? What do you prioritise over growing in your faith? The answers to those questions may well be the other gods you have in your life.

If we are honest, we all struggle with having other idols and gods in our life. So, we need to ask God to help us identify them and overcome them. We should be striving to fight against idols and put God first in our lives. But we can't rely on our own strength to do that. We must rely on the resources God gives us by reading His word, praying to Him and seeking support and counsel from fellow Christians. We must remember that we can always come before God in prayer and repent. We can ask for forgiveness and for a renewed heart, so we can place Him in the centre of our life. God is gracious to us. Jesus died for us while we were still sinners so that those who believe in him may be brought into a right relationship with God (Romans 5:8). God is at work, changing us to be more like Jesus (Philippians 2:13-14). If Jesus is the Lord and Saviour of your life, be assured that God has saved you and that He is committed to growing and transforming you for His glory. *God bless, Pastor John.*
