# EVEN IF IT DOESN'T MAKE SENSE

"But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners." (Romans 5:8)

Sometimes God does things that just don't seem to make sense to us - but that doesn't mean we can't trust him. In the Bible, God often asked his people to do things that just didn't seem to make sense. While they were in the wilderness God still asked the Israelites to give him the first and best of their crops and herds. If you're a farmer, that DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. God rescued the Israelites out of Egypt, where there was an abundance of food and water, and took them into the wilderness where there was very little water or food. That DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. When Gideon was preparing to fight against the huge Midianite army, God told him to take only 300 men. That DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. The more you read the Bible, the more you see examples of events that don't make logical sense from a human perspective. But here's the wonderful truth we can't ignore. While God's commands don't always make sense, they do motivate us to step out in faith and put our trust in Him. Of course, it doesn't make sense to give away your best animals, but God wanted his people to trust him for their future. Of course, food and water are scarce in the desert, but God wanted his people to depend on him for their daily bread. Of course, it makes no sense to fight an army with almost no men, but God wanted them to know who really has the power.

And let's not forget the biggest, strangest, and most amazing thing that God did that DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. As human beings, we were the ones who chose to disobey God and reject Him. As sinners, we were the ones who broke our relationship with God and we are the ones who deserve to be punished and rejected. But that's not what God chose to do. Instead, he did the most ultimate thing that DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. He sent Jesus to die for us, even though we were his enemies. Even though Jesus did nothing wrong he died a criminal's death. Even though we deserved to die for our sins, Jesus died for us instead. As a result, when we (the ones who deserve death) put our trust in Christ, we can be forgiven and accepted as children of God. That DOESN'T MAKE SENSE. But that's the good news of the gospel. Even though God's plan of salvation doesn't make sense to us, it is more wonderful and more powerful than we could ever imagine. So don't be afraid to always put your faith in God – even if it DOESN'T MAKE SENSE at the time. You will always be blessed when you do.
