As Christians we shouldn't be surprised by the world's opposition to our faith because Jesus made it clear that this would happen to anyone who followed him (John 15:18-19). He not only told us to expect persecution. He also encouraged us to embrace it when it comes (Matthew 5:10-12). But is it reasonable to do that? Is it even possible to do that? It is because we know that our God is sovereign and that nothing happens apart from his plan - which means that in some way our suffering is God's will. It's not a mistake. It's not meaningless. It's an opportunity to respond to God's sovereignty with hope, trust, and godly character. It's an opportunity to shine God's light in the midst of darkness. Persecution proves our citizenship. Suffering for Christ's sake shows that we belong to God and not the world. It proves that we are taking up our cross and following him (Luke 9:23). **Persecution displays our faith.** It proves the validity and the strength of our faith. You'll never know how strong your arms are until you have to lift something heavy, and you'll never know what your faith is made of until it is put to the test. Many fall away when their faith is tested; but those who truly love the Lord will persevere and emerge with their faith tested, proven, strengthened (James 1:12). Persecution shapes your character. It takes tremendous heat and pressure to form a diamond deep in the ground and it takes suffering to form Christian character deep in your heart. Persecution is a means God uses to conform you to the image of Christ (Romans 5:3-4). Persecution equips you for service. Through persecution, God is equipping us to better serve Him and others (2 Corinthians 1:4). Persecution produces greater fellowship with other believers. As we share in our sufferings, we also share in God's comfort and blessings (2 Corinthians 1:6-7). Persecution causes us to look forward and beyond this world and long for the glorious eternal life to come. It reminds us that this world is not our home and that the Kingdom still to come is our true and final home. "For our present troubles are small and won't last very long. Yet they produce for us a glory that vastly outweighs them and will last forever! So, we don't look at the troubles we can see now. Rather, we fix our gaze on things that cannot be seen. For the things we see now will soon be gone, but the things we cannot see will last forever." (2 Corinthians 4:17-18) So, let us not fear the opposition we face from the world. Let us always remember that even in our worst suffering and our most agonizing persecution, we can rejoice and be glad because God is with us and He is accomplishing his perfect purpose.


