ALL, EVERY, NONE AND NOT A SINGLE ONE

As the Israelites travelled from Egypt to the Promised Land they were prone to doubt God's strength, power, plans and promises. Time and time again they questioned whether he would lead them to the glorious place that would be their home and their rest. Despite their constant grumblings and doubts, God always proved his faithfulness to them. This doubt and rebellion continued until they finally reached the borders of the Promised Land. Now under the leadership of Joshua, they cross the Jordan and by the strength of the Lord they experience victory after victory. Bit by bit and battle by battle they conquer their enemies and finally find the peace and blessings that God had promised. In chapter 21 of Joshua we read a stirring summary of their success and, even more so, an inspiring summary of God's faithfulness. "So the Lord gave to Israel all the land he had sworn to give their ancestors, and they took possession of it and settled there. And the Lord gave them rest on every side, just as he had solemnly promised their ancestors. None of their enemies could stand against them, for the Lord helped them conquer all their enemies. Not a single one of all the good promises the Lord had given to the family of Israel was left unfulfilled; everything he had spoken came true." (Joshua 21:43-45) God had done all that he said he would do. He proved true to his every promise. Not one word was broken, not one promise was left unfulfilled. He showed himself to be supremely reliable.

Like the Israelites, we are currently living in a place between Egypt and the Promised Land. We have been justified, but not yet glorified. We may not physically wander in a desert and follow pillars of cloud and fire, but we are followers of Jesus, and we are just as dependent upon the goodness, grace, power and promises of God. It is these assurances that sustain us when the way ahead seems long and uncertain and when our enemies rise up against us. Just as he promised to lead his people to the safety of the Promised Land, the Lord has promised to lead us safely to heaven. The day will come when the story of our lives will be summarized with the same superlatives Joshua used. One day it will be said that the Lord gave us all that he had said he would give us. One day we will enter into his glorious presence and be safe from every spiritual attack where **none** of our enemies (including death) can harm us again. As we rejoice in His eternal and perfect rest we will know that not a single one of His good promises has failed. As we look forward to that day, may we always be mindful of the 'all, every, none and not a single one' and praise the name of our awesome


