PART OF GOD'S FAMILY

About a year or so ago I bought two books to read to Elijah at night, and he is quite good at memorising parts of books that we read to him very regularly. One is called 'Splat' which is all about the parable of the two builders, and Elijah loves to make the rain sounds and make a big splat noise when the house comes tumbling down. The other book is called "How Can I Pray", which is all about the Lord's prayer, and obviously uses child friendly language. The book takes you through how God isn't pleased with people who pray in front of a crowd to look good, or people who say great big long prayers filled with lots and lots of words, and it goes "blah blah" (Elijah loves to say this part). But then right at the end someone asks Jesus, "How come we can talk to God like he's our dad?" And at this moment I now like to stop and ask Elijah this question, and just recently he has started replying with "because Jesus died on the cross". Now I know that Elijah probably has no idea what those words mean, despite my best efforts to explain it to him, but he is probably just echoing the words that have been read to him many times. But that doesn't make it any less true. You and I as believers, can talk to God as our heavenly Father, and as children of God because Jesus died on the cross. He has made a way for us to talk directly to God, for such is the power of the once for all sacrifice of Jesus. "God sent him to buy freedom for us who were slaves to the law, so that he could adopt us as his very own children.⁶And because we are his children, God has sent the Spirit of his Son into our hearts, prompting us to call out, "Abba, Father." Now you are no longer a slave but God's own child. And since you are his child, God has made you his heir" (Galatians 4:5-7).
