"A Better Focus" *August* (Hobsonys 12:1, 1) (Hebrews 12:1-13)

Thought for the Week

In Hebrews 12:1-13 God clearly reminds us of the fact that faith is much more than just a fleeting rush of adrenalin that overwhelms us during a moment of deep emotion. Faithfulness is also not a 'fair weather' attitude of delight when life is good, and the future looks bright. Faith is fully embracing the goodness, power and providence of God even when things seem to be falling apart. Faithfulness is a determination to finish the race that God has set before us – regardless of the aching limbs, the painful training, the dangerous obstacles, the dark storms and the temptations that we will experience along the way. In order to help us do this, the author of Hebrews gives us two great practical applications to help us stay on track.

Firstly, we need to rely on the grace of God to persevere through the race. Whenever you find yourself running into the headwinds of adversity, when you start to stagger with doubts and when the world taunts your every step, ask God to give you the strength to endure. His answer to your prayer may involve more uncomfortable training or painful discipline, but you can be assured that you are in in safe, loving and mighty hands. Isaiah 40:29-31 is a powerful reminder of God's provision of strength throughout your life. "He gives power to the weak and strength to the powerless. Even youths will become weak and tired, and young men will fall in exhaustion. But those who trust in the Lord will find new strength. They will soar high on wings like eagles. They will run and not grow weary. They will walk and not faint."

Secondly, remember that you are never alone in the race. Nothing dampens your spirit when you are striving in your spiritual marathon like the feeling that you're alone. The truth is you are not alone. Consider the prayer of Sottish preacher John Baillie. "I thank you Lord, that this Christian journey that I am on is no untried or uncharted road. It is a well worn path that has been beaten hard by the footsteps of apostles, prophets martyrs and all my fellow believers." You must remember that thousands upon thousands of faithful men and women have run the same path as you. The Lord Jesus himself has marked it with the suffering he endured on the cross. In his resurrection and ascension, he has also highlights the guaranteed, glorious prize that awaits us at the finish line. When we look to him with hope, keep our eyes on him and remember the example of those who ran before us, our strength will be renewed with each step. And when we understand that God is disciplining us along the way – not as a frustrated coach, but as a loving father – our confidence will grow with every stride.
