In my early teenage years (in the says when Sunday School wasn't held during the service) I remember how the maps in my Bible helped me get through many a sermon. As I lost interest in listening to my dad preach, I would flip to the maps that were located at the back of my Bible. One of my favourite maps was the one that traced the route the Israelites followed after they escaped from Egypt and began to make their way toward the Promised Land. The route they followed was far from straight and it hardly looked like the most efficient way to go from Egypt to Canaan. If you didn't know better It would be easy to think that the Israelites were confused, indecisive and lacking clear direction. Yet we know that they were following the Lord's directives. He is the one who would tell them when to camp and when to move, when to go straight, and when to turn to the left or the right. So, in essence the meandering line on the map was all part of the fulfillment of God's good and perfect will.

There are times when it is good for us to look back on our own lives and to think about the journey we have travelled from birth to where we are today.

As we do that we will see –

•How we have all passed through certain trials and avoided many more.

•How we have scaled some mountains of joy and gone through valleys of grief and regret.

•How we have turned one way toward success and another way toward failure.

Our path through this life has been winding and twisting, rarely perfectly straight and rarely avoiding every hindrance and every stretch of wilderness. And just like God was leading the Israelites on their journey, we can have every confidence that he has been leading us on ours. Just like every twist and every turn they took was within the wise providence of God, so it is with every step we've taken forward and every step we've taken back. He planned that we would approach mountains, valleys, rivers and seas and he has used them all for his good purposes. Just as He promised the Israelites, that they would safely reach the end of their journey, he has promised that we will also reach ours. For like them, he is leading us to the Promised Land, the land of peace, the land of rest, the land where we most truly long to be. He is leading us to a better home, an unshakeable Kingdom. So, let us trust Him and praise Him as he leads us each day.
