

# Thought for the Week

#### SAFE AND SOUND IN OUR MIGHTY FORTRESS

People were seldom, if ever, frightened inside the Murud-Janiira fortress off the coast of India. It was built to provide protection from pirates and was rated as one of the most impenetrable forts in the old world. It's surrounded by water, has 12 metres high walls and only has one entrance for its 572 cannons to protect. Over the centuries, it has been besieged by the British, the Portuguese, and various Arabic nations, but none of them were able to conquer it. In an uncertain and threatening world, it was a place of total safety for all who took refuge inside its walls. As David was experiencing a season of desperation he composed Psalm 62 and in that song he talks about an even better, more eternal place of safety and refuge. "I wait quietly before God, for my victory comes from him. He alone is my rock and my salvation, my fortress where I will never be shaken." (vs1-2) David had many troubling experiences during his lifetime. He lived for years as a fugitive, was engaged in many battles with his enemies and often had the threat of death looming over him. In the face of such adversity, David would understandably feel vulnerable and overwhelmed. In these circumstances it would be normal to panic, but instead of doing that, David preaches to his troubled and fragile heart. In this song he affirms that power and wealth (vs 9-10) are not a lasting source of comfort and security. He also reminds himself, and us, that it is only in God and His promises that we will find a refuge and a fortress where we may flee when we feel weak, vulnerable and fragile. Promises such as "I will never leave you nor forsake you" (Hebrews 13:5), "My God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus" (Philippians 4:19), "Do not be anxious about your life, what you will eat or drink,.. about your body, what you will put on.. . But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you." (Matthew 6:25, 33) and hundreds more. In our desperate season, when something or someone is threatening our hope, and we feel on the verge of collapse, we must turn from looking at the threat and instead look to the source of our hope. It is in these times of desperation that we really learn what it means to pray and to trust God. Few things move you to pour out your heart to God in earnest prayer than when everything seems chaotic, and you wonder if you're going to make it. Most people don't run into a fortress unless they're faced with real danger coming their way. So, if you are feeling threatened today, or whenever those times of desperation come again, preach to your troubled heart about the guaranteed refuge and victory we can have with God our mighty fortress.
