

FEAR NOT

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus." (Philippians 4:6-7)

It doesn't take much to look around us and get a sense that the spirit of fear seems to be working overtime. Wars, weather, financial insecurity, immorality, violence and persecution seem to give us every reason to be fearful for 2024. But the spirit of fear does not come from God and it can be crippling to anyone who holds on to it. The devil wants us to be afraid. He wants us to be so overwhelmed that we cannot accomplish the things we need to do. Remember, if God is for us, no one can be against us. We are overcomers! We are to hold fast to God and stand strong. Even though our nation seems to be intent on silencing and suppressing those who want to share the gospel, we can't let that frighten us. Believers have faced that challenge throughout history and God has always had the same advice. "Don't be afraid! Speak out! Don't be silent! For I am with you, and no one will attack and harm you, for many people in this city belong to me." (Acts 18:9-10) Be comforted by the promise that God that is sovereign and be at peace in knowing that we are never alone.
