

Thought for the Week

#### THE RESURRECTION MAKES A HUGE DIFFERENCE

The resurrection is not just something we celebrate once a year at Easter with our families. The resurrection is the most important truth of the Bible. Jesus did what he promised to do.

He died for our sins and he came out of the grave victorious over death. That means that through Jesus Christ we have victory over our past, in the present and for eternity.

Our Past – The Bible tells us we are separated from God because He is holy, and we are not. We have all sinned and fallen short of the glory of God (Romans 3:23). We cannot measure up to His standard and we cannot get to heaven in our own imperfection. So, God devised a plan to save us and sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to live a perfect life, and to go to the cross to pay the penalty for our sin. The fact that he rose again meant that he paid for all sins, for if any had been unpaid for, he would not have been released by God. Therefore, no matter what we have done, our past has been taken care of. Jesus has paid our penalty and when we place our trust in Him for the forgiveness of our sin we can go to heaven. Our Present - Most people are surprised that the resurrection has anything to do with the present, but the Bible tells us that God gives us the same power that was used to bring Jesus back from the dead, so that we can live our lives every day in resurrection power. "The Spirit of God, who raised Jesus from the dead, lives in you. And just as God raised Christ Jesus from the dead, he will give life to your mortal bodies by this same Spirit living within you." (Romans 8:11) We struggle when we try to live the Christian life in our own strength. But if we will depend on the power of God for help, He will empower us to overcome and live a victorious life for Him. Our Future - The quarantee of eternal life for believers all hinges on the resurrection of Jesus Christ. If Christ hadn't come out of the grave, we would have no hope at all. But when we place our trust in the Lord Jesus and ask Him to forgive us of our sins, to save us and to come and live within our lives, we receive the gift of eternal life and the guarantee of heaven (Romans 6:23). As Christians, we no longer have to fear death, because we have an incredible hope—the hope that one day we will be with God forever. And it's not a "hope so" hope; it's a "know so" hope.


