THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

In the most recent book that I am reading, 'Truth on Fire' by Adam Ramsey, he opens his book and presents his purpose for the book by stating this: "Imagine if an intelligent faith and a passionate faith were both realities in your discipleship to Jesus. Imagine churches that were known both for both a high view of the Holy Scriptures as well as a high view of the Holy Spirit... To behold him in such a way that our daily experience is transformed with a deepened awareness of who it is we pray to, who it is that is with us, and who it is that we are loved by. To think about our God more deeply, in order to enjoy him more intensely. To let God's truth set our hearts on fire."

We do not study the Word of God deeply, read theology books, or preach doctrine to puff up, or to cause us to become prideful, boasting in our own knowledge. We study the Word of God, in order that we may know God more deeply. And as we behold God's glory, that should reflect in our lives through a passionate, joyful relationship with Jesus Christ that gladly bends the knee to him, that we might boast only in Jesus Christ. As we do this, as we remember our first love, as we daily recall the gospel in our lives, and the Holy Spirit, 'the beautifier of our souls' (John Owen) conforms us to the image of Jesus Christ, we will find that the truth that has been revealed in the written Word of God will set our hearts on fire, for a rich, joyful, sanctifying, God-glorifying relationship that will be contagious to all those around us. Knowledge and experience are not opposites in the Christian life, they are two sides of the same coin. The more we know Christ, the more full and deep our relationship with Jesus will be.

"Indeed, I count everything as loss because of the surpassing worth of knowing Christ Jesus my Lord. For his sake, I have suffered the loss of all things and count them as rubbish, in order that I may gain Christ and be found in him". (Philippians 3:8-9a)
