HOW SHOULD WE LOVE OUR ENEMIES?

Extracts from the Enough Rope interview between Andrew Denton and Johnny Lee Clary – December 31, 2012

Johnny Lee Clary was a violent white supremacist who had become the Grand Dragon of the Ku Klux Klan in Oklahoma at the age of 21. He eventually went on to become the Grand Imperial Wizard for the KKK for all of the USA.

He was pitted against a black Oklahoma pastor, Reverend Wade Watts, in a TV debate. Johnny was humiliated on TV by this humble man. Later on, to get back at him, they showed up in their sheets and hoods and threw trash all over the lawn of the manse. They called out, "Get on out here, boy, we got something for you." Pastor Watts came out and said, "Boys, Halloween's four more months away. I got no trick or treat in here for you. Come back in October." And turned and went back in the house.

A week later they burned a cross across the street from the manse. Pastor Watts came outside and asked them if they needed hotdogs or marshmallows for their BBQ! Johnny got tired of this so next they tried to burn the church down. Johnny then tried to disguise his voice and he called up Pastor Watts and said, "Hey, boy, you'd better be afraid. We're coming to get you, boy. You don't know who we are but we know who you are." And the pastor replied, "Hello, Johnny, a man like you takes the time to call me, I'm so honoured." Then he said, "Let me do something to you. Dear Lord, please forgive Johnny for being so stupid. He doesn't mean to be so ornery, he's a good boy trying to get out somewhere in there." Johnny hung up the phone.

On another day they watched him go into a restaurant, Johnny went in with 30 KKK members. The pastor had a chicken dinner in front of him so Johnny said "Hey, boy, this restaurant's for white people only, we don't want you here. So, I'm gonna make you a promise, I promise you we're gonna do the same thing to you that you do to that chicken. So you think real hard before you touch that chicken." So he looked at the Klan, then he picked up the chicken and he kissed it. And when he kissed the chicken, the whole restaurant broke out laughing, even the Klan were laughing. They never bothered the pastor again.

Johnny Lee Clary soon started to realise that the KKK did not hold the answers to his inner turmoil. He left the Klan in a violent way. He was shattered and at 30 he felt he now had nothing. He picked up his gun and was going to commit suicide. As he did, he noticed a Bible on the table and decided he should see if there was a prayer in there he could read. God spoke to him through the Word and he broke down and committed his life to God.

He then broke to Pastor Watts and asked him for forgiveness. The Pastor asked if Johnny would give his testimony at church, his church, a black community church – and he did. Since then, Johnny Lee Clary has campaigned to help radicalised youth to know the love of Jesus.

How do we love those who we feel are unlovable? We need to see them as God sees them, as souls who desperately need the love of God in their life.

May God teach us and humble us in this matter
