Thought for the Week

Charles Finney was a lawyer from New York in the 1800s. At the age of 29, he was converted and spent much time in prayer and fasting. Finney guit his law practice and went into ministry. The Lord used him greatly to bring about revival in the USA. It is estimated that over 100,000 people were converted during his revival meetings.

What was the main secret of his spiritual success? He had two faithful intercessors, Daniel Nash and Abel Clary, who believed in fervent prayer. They would go ahead to the cities where Finney was going to preach and they would cry out to God and weep in prayer for those cities. God honoured their prevailing prayers and sent revival.

James 5:16b says "the earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results."

How earnest are our prayers when we come to God? Do you feel that sometimes your prayers are not answered? Do we weep over Coolum? Sometimes not seeing answers is due to our lack of sincerity with God but sometimes it is because God is asking us to wait.

Many years ago, I saw a handwritten note inside my grandmother's small Bible. In that note she prayed for the salvation of her immediate family and also for her extended family. After she had passed away, many years later my two brothers, myself, our mother and eventually our father were converted.

Sometimes it is not given for us to see the answers to our prayers. But God, in His infinite power and knowledge, answers prayers according to His will and in His time

Let us be fervent, faithful and patient in our prayers.
