In Genesis 17:8, God made a forever covenant with Abraham in regard to the land of Israel "And I will give the entire land of Canaan, where you now live as a foreigner, to you and your descendants. It will be their possession forever, and I will be their God."

In Exodus 19:5&6, God made a conditional covenant with Moses about how He would bless the Hebrew people. "Now therefore, if you will indeed obey My voice and keep My covenant, then you shall be a special treasure to Me above all people; for all the earth is Mine. And you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation"
