Thought for the Week

WHERE IS YOUR PRIORITY?

In Luke chapter 8, Jesus tells a parable about a wealthy man who decided to build bigger and bigger barns to store up more grain (wealth) so that he could retire very, very comfortably. At the end of the parable, after describing the rich man storing up all he has, Jesus said in verses 20 and 21"But God said to him, 'You fool! This very night your life will be demanded from you. Then who will get what you have prepared for yourself? This is how it will be with whoever stores up things for themselves but is not rich toward God."

I'm reminded of Mark 8:36 "And what do you benefit if you gain the whole world but lose your own soul?"

So let me ask you this, when you die, not if you die, but when you die, will you get to take anything with you? The answer is no, what you do in this life, the things you strive for will all pass away, only your soul will live on in eternity. Therefore, we should be far more concerned with the condition of our soul and its eternal destination rather than the temporal things of this world. Our wealth and stuff can distract us from the Gospel of Jesus and cause us to chase after the trappings of this world rather than eternity with Jesus.

Therefore let us store up treasure in Heaven, where rust and moths do not destroy. Jesus says in Mark 12:34 "For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also."

May we all keep our priority on our relationship with God rather than our relationship with our bank manager!
