THE GULL WAS ONLY THE FIRST MIRACLE

In October, 1942, Captain Eddie Rickenbacker was on a mission in a B-17 to deliver an important message to General Douglas MacArthur in New Guinea. Somewhere over the South Pacific the Flying Fortress became lost and out of radio reach. Fuel ran dangerously low, so the men ditched their plane in the ocean. For nearly a month Captain Eddie and his companions would fight the water, and the weather, and the scorching sun. Sharks, some bigger than their rafts rammed them. Eight days into their journey their rations were destroyed by the salt water. It would take a miracle to survive. Every day John Bartek would read the Bible out loud. One afternoon he ran a service and finished with a prayer for deliverance. After that, Eddie Rickenbacker pulled his hat down over his eyes and dozed off.

Rickenbacker woke as something landed on his head, it was a sea gull! The gull meant food...if he could catch it! Captain Eddie caught the gull, the flesh was eaten and the intestines were used for bait to catch fish. The fishing enabled them to survive until rescued.

But the biggest miracle was not the seagull. One of the crew, James Whittaker was not a believer and complained every day about the Bible readings. But the soil of Whittaker's heart was being ploughed by the Word of God. At the moment the seagull landed on Rickenbacker's head, Whittaker gave his heart to the Lord.

The Word of God divided the despair of doubt from Whittaker's heart and instilled a faith in a Saviour. The angels rejoice at every soul that surrenders to the Lordship of Christ.
