## Thought for the Week

"Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved, a worker who does not need to be ashamed and who correctly handles the word of truth." (2 Timothy 2:15)

Step 1: Observation ("What does it say?")

- Submit to the Authority of God's Word
- Resist the temptation to pick and choose what you pay attention to, or to place yourself in judgement over God's Word.

Step 2: Interpretation ("What does it mean?")

- Carefully and reverently interpret the text you are reading or studying
- Exegesis aims to discover the intended meaning of the passage, whereas Eisegesis forces our own ideas into the passage.
- Make use of prayer, slow reflection, other relevant passages, study bibles, commentaries and discussion with other believers.

Step 3: Application ("What should I do?")

- Humbly respond in obedience to God's Word
- We haven't rightly handled the Bible until we have considered our obedient response to what God is saying through it.
