

# Thought for the Week

### Coolum Beach Baptist Church Statement of Faith (Part Two)

2.5 We believe in the existence of created beings called angels, who serve God as ministering spirits. We believe in the existence of the Devil, a fallen angel, who is also called the Serpent and Satan. He has followers, other fallen angels, evil spiritual beings, who serve him (Matt. 18:10; 12:24; Heb. 1:14; Jude 6; Luke 10:18; Eph 6:11–12; Ezek 28:11–15; 1 Tim 4:1; 2 Pet. 2:4; Is. 14:12–15; Rev 12:9–12)

2.6 We believe in the creation of the world – a world that God called very good. We believe that Adam and Eve were directly created by God and that they rebelled against His authority and fell into sin. With sin came the curse on the earth and death to the whole human race, who are all born with a sinful nature and are lost (Gen 1:1, 26-27; 2:18, 21-25; 3:1-19; Rom 5:12; 3:23).

2.7 We believe that God graciously offers us salvation from the penalty and power of sin on the basis of the finished work of Jesus Christ, who died as a substitute for sinners; as a Lamb to make atonement for our sins. Our sins were laid on Him and He was judged and punished accordingly. (Acts 2:22-24; Rom 5:1-11; 1 Cor 15:3; 1 Pet 2:24; John 1:29; Heb 9:28; Gen 22:8, 14; 1 Tim. 2:5-6).

**2.8** We believe the Holy Spirit convicts us of our sin, and convinces us of our need of a Saviour and of the judgment to come. (John 16:7ff, 1 Thess. 1:10: Acts 2:37–38).

- Praise God that He created and rules over all things and has authority over all things (Mark 4:39)
- Pray that we will "worship God acceptably with reverence and awe" (Heb 12:28), and thus not need to be afraid of any other person or circumstance in our lives (Mark 4:40)
