

Coolum Beach Baptist Church Statement of Faith (Part Three)

- 2.9 We believe it is the Holy Spirit who gives us new birth (who regenerates us, re-creates us) as we believe in Christ. It is the Holy Spirit who comes to dwell within us. He gives us power to live for God and gives us gifts and fruit of the Spirit. Evidence of this work of the Spirit is our desire to live a holy life and our carefulness to maintain good works. (John 3:5-6; 1Cor 6:11-19; 12:4-13; Gal. 5:22-25; Eph 2:10; 4:24; Tit. 3:8).
- **2.10** We believe the necessity of repentance towards God and of faith in the Lord Jesus Christ in order to personally experience salvation (Acts2:37-39; 3:19; 16:31; 20:21)
- **2.11** We believe that to be baptized is to follow Christ's example and to obey His command as set forth in the great commission. (Matt. 3:13–17; 28:18–20; Acts 2:41; 8:36–39; Rom 6:3–5).
- **2.12** We believe that the Lord's Supper is a celebration for believers to remember Christ's sacrificial death for us, until He comes again. (Mark 14:17-25; 1 Cor 11:23-29).
- 2.13 We believe Christ will return, the dead will be resurrected, and final judgement will take place. Those who truly know Jesus as their Lord and Saviour will, with great joy, be with Him forevermore. All others will be lost and separated from Him eternally in a place of torment, called hell. It is for this reason that we seek to warn others and win them to Christ. (1 Cor 15; 2Cor 5:10-11; 1 Thess. 1:10; 4:13-18; 5:9-12; Rev. 19:11-16; 20:11-15; 2 Pet. 3:9-15).
